

Dr. Elmon Krupnik serves as Chief of the Chaplain Service at the Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Phoenix, Arizona. Ordained and endorsed by the Evangelical Church Alliance, he also serves on its board and is Chairman of the Military Chaplain Commission. Chaplain Krupnik is the State Chaplain (with the rank of Colonel) for the New Mexico National Guard. Dr. Krupnik holds a Ph.D. in Education from Capella University, an M.Div. from Midwestern Baptist Theological Semi-

nary, and a B.A. in History from the University of Minnesota. In addition, he has completed graduate coursework for an M.A. in History from Xavier University. His military education includes completion of Senior Service College by the Department of Army, U.S. Air Force Air War College, Marine Corps Command and General Staff College, and the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College (all by correspondence). Dr. Krupnik serves as an adjunct faculty member for the Marine Corps University and at various community colleges in the areas of history, religion, philosophy, psychology, and sociology. He also authored a devotional book, "The Sole Balm." Chaplain Krupnik has been married to his wife, Lynn, a practicing attorney, for 37 years. They have four children and 14 grandchildren.


