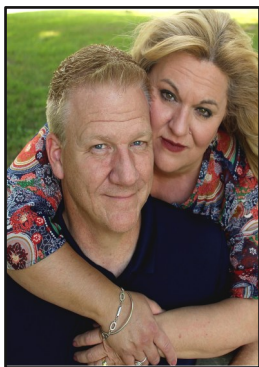


II Timothy 4:1-5

Rev. Joseph M. Lee served for over a decade as Lead Pastor of a multicultural English ministry at Jesus Love Church in Seoul, South Korea (2013–2024), where he founded and led ministry among international communities through preaching, worship planning, interdenominational prayer, discipleship and evangelism training, and pastoral care, as well as outreach across universities, cities, and military-base regions. His ministry has also included coordinating short-term missions throughout Africa and Asia, as well as extensive work with refugees, diaspora communities, and adoptive families, while fostering cross-cultural Christian living. He regularly organized and spoke at seminars, discipleship programs, and evangelism training sessions. Ordained previously in South Korea and now with the Evangelical Church Alliance (ECA), he holds a Master of Divinity from Reformed Theological Seminary in Seoul, completed the Council of Youth Anti-Drug (COYAD) program in Atlanta, and studied Finance at Rutgers University, New Jersey. Rev. Lee now serves as Special Assistant to the President, as well as Clerk of the Standards and Credentials Committee for the ECA, overseeing ordination, licensure, and membership processes while providing pastoral encouragement.



Revs. Randy and Marli Brown have been married for 37 years and served in music ministry for just as long. They graduated from William Tyndale College and are both ordained with the Evangelical Church Alliance (ECA). Randy & Marli Ministries, their love-offering based concert and speaking ministry, takes them all over the nation ministering to churches in all evangelical denominations. 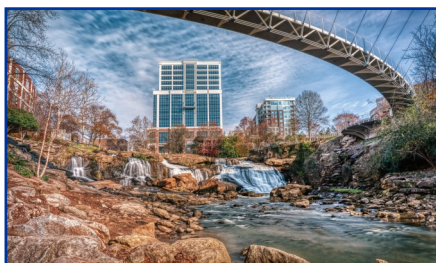
